**FORM FOR GRANTING AUTHORIZATION FOR COLLECTION/
STORAGE/DISMANTLING OF E-WASTE**

1. (a) Authorization **06/E-Waste/Auth./HO/CECB/2016** and (b) date of issue
2. The operator of facility i.e. occupier of **M/s Namo E-Waste Management Limited, Khasra No.-248/2, Village-Thekbandha, Navapara, Abhanpur, Distt.-Raipur (C.G.)** is hereby granted an authorization for Collection Centre of IT Goods (Eg. PC, Laptops, Printers etc) and Non-IT (Consumer Electronics & Appliances etc) under E-Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2011 at **Village-Thekbandha, Navapara, Abhanpur, Distt.-Raipur (C.G.)**
3. The authorization shall be in force for a period of **Five Years** from date of issue of this authorization.
4. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and such conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Terms and conditions of authorization

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the Chhattisgarh Environment Conservation Board.
3. Industry shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the e-waste without obtaining prior permission of the Chhattisgarh Environment Conservation Board.
4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment as working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of his authorization.
5. It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the Chhattisgarh Environment Conservation Board to close down the operations.
6. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made as laid down in sub-rule (6) of rule 9.
7. This authorization for Collection Centre is valid for following E-Wastes & capacity:-

S.No.	E-Waste	Quantity/Year
1.	IT Goods (Eg. PC, Laptops, Printers etc) and Non-IT (Consumer Electronics & Appliances etc)	450 MT



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8. Industry shall ensure that no damage is caused to the Environment during storage and transportation of e-waste.
9. The authorized Collection Centre shall follow the guidelines for implementation of the E-Waste (M&H) Rules, 2011 published by the Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
10. The collection, transportation, storage & handling operations in a collection centre should be operated in such a way so that it does not cause any damage to the surroundings.
11. The collection centre shall provide details such as address, telephone numbers/helpline number, e-mail etc. to the general public.
12. The collection centre shall ensure that the e-waste collected by them is stored in a secured manner till it is sent to registered dismantler or recycler for disposal.
13. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated, and such conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
14. The collection centre shall maintain records of the e-waste handled in Form-2 and make such records available for scrutiny by the State Pollution Control Board or the Pollution Control Committee concerned.
15. The collection centre shall file annual return in form-3 as per rules 4(9), 5(4), 6(2), 7(7), 8(5) and 9(5) of the E-Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2011 and submit to CECB on or before 30th June following the financial year to which that returns relates.
16. Board reserves the right to cancel/amend the above conditions and add new conditions as and when deemed necessary.
